Please consider my candidacy for the Faculty Personnel Committee. Since joining the University of Oregon in 2011 (prior TTF Assistant Professor positions at University of Wisconsin-Madison [2009-2011] and Portland State University [2008-2009]) I have served in a variety of service and leadership roles including prior service as Chair of the Special Education Doctoral Committee (**program service**); Director of Graduate Programs for both the Special Education Programs and the Applied Behavior Analysis Program (**department service**); Interim Director of the HEDCO Clinic and the College of Education TTF Faculty Personnel Committee (**college service**); and member of the graduate research funding awards committee for the Center for the Study of Women in Society and member of the Advisory Committee to the Office of the Provost for the Institutional Hiring Plan (**university service**).

I routinely serve as an external reviewer for P&T cases (TTF and CNTF) and have reviewed grant applications for federal agencies and not for profit organizations in the U.S. and in other countries. I have 14 years experience on the editorial boards of peer-reviewed journals. Roles to highlight include Editor-in-Chief of a multidisciplinary rehabilitation journal, *Developmental Neurorehabilitation* (since 2013), and Co-Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Positive Behavior Interventions* (since 2020). Over the past 16 years in higher education, I have selected service opportunities in relation to my sincere interest in supporting the advancement of scholarship of other faculty within and outside of my own fields of study. If elected to the Faculty Personnel Committee, I will work in earnest to provide a fair and equitable review of each faculty dossier and will collaborate with esteemed colleagues across the University to uphold the Promotion and Tenure process defined by the University of Oregon.
