Herman Faculty Achievement Award for Distinguished Teaching.

Terms and Workload

Length of Term

- Non-Students: 2 years, staggered
- Students: 1 year

Term Limits

- For the Chair: 20 - 40 hours/year (Tier 2)
- For committee members: 0 - 20 hours/year (Tier 3)
