ARTICLE 8: INTERINSTITUTIONAL FACULTY SENATE (IFS)

8.1 Inter-institutional Faculty Senate. Created by the State Board of Higher Education in 1970, The Inter-institutional Faculty Senate (IFS) brings together faculty voices from the public universities in Oregon, as defined by ORS Chapter 352.

8.2 The University of Oregon has three voting IFS members, as follows: 1) the President of the University of Oregon Senate or designee; 2) the President-Elect (Vice President) of the University of Oregon Senate; 3) two statutory faculty members of the University of Oregon Senate who will serve for a term of two years. Elections for this position will be held during the Senate meeting when the election for the President-Elect (Vice President) of the UO Senate is held. Elections for the Statutory Faculty members of the Senate will be held during the Fall term each academic year.

8.3 In the Fall 2025, one Statutory Faculty member of the Senate will be elected for a one-year term, and one Statutory Faculty member will be elected for a two-year term. Section 8.3 will expire after the election of new IFS members during the Fall 2025 term.
