## **ARTICLE 8: INTERINSTITUTIONAL FACULTY SENATE (IFS)**

**8.1 Inter-institutional Faculty Senate.** Created by the State Board of Higher Education in 1970, The Inter-institutional Faculty Senate (IFS) brings together faculty voices from the public universities in Oregon, as defined by ORS Chapter 352.

8.2 The University of Oregon has three voting IFS members, as follows: 1) the President of the University of Oregon Senate or designee; 2) the President-Elect (Vice President) of the University of Oregon Senate; 3) two members of the Statutory Faculty, who will serve for a term of two years. Elections for this position will be held during the Senate meeting when the election for the President-Elect (Vice President) of the UO Senate is held. Elections for the Statutory Faculty members will be held during the annual Spring term Senate and Committee elections beginning in Spring 2026.

8.3 Two Statutory Faculty seats on the IFS will be elected by a majority vote of the UO Senate for 1-year terms during the University of Oregon Senate meeting on June 4, 2025

Section 8.3 will expire and will be deleted from the UO Senate bylaws on June 5, 2025.
