Senate Budget Committee: Purpose

- Offers insight and facilitates discussions on university financial matters, including budget policies, key decisions, and long-term fiscal strategies.
- Analyzes budget reports submitted to the UO Board of Trustees and gathers financial data from university administration.
- Regularly reviews financial reports affecting the university's budget from the Governor, the Oregon Legislature, the UO Board of Trustees, and the UO Foundation.
- Has the option to initiate a study of financial issues and develop recommendations for Senate action.
- Provides regular updates at Senate meetings on the university's financial status and overall fiscal health.

Membership: Representation

Nine members will be elected from the following Senate constituencies:

- 1 non-faculty staff member representing classified staff
- 1 non-faculty staff member representing the officers of administration
- 3 members of the Statutory Faculty representing the Professional Schools and Colleges (at large)
- 4 members of the Statutory Faculty representing the College of Arts and Sciences (at large)
- Four members of the committee are Ex-Officio:
 - Ex Officio: Senate President or designee (voting) (no term limits)
 - Ex Officio: The University President or their designee (non-voting) (no term limit)
 - Ex Officio: The Provost or their designee (non-voting) (no term limits)
 - Ex Officio: Vice President for Finance and Administration or their designee (non-voting) (no term limits)

Membership: Term Structure & Limits

- **Term Length:** Each term lasts 2 years
- **Staggered Terms:** Elections are staggered to ensure continuity
- Term Limits: Members can serve up to three consecutive terms (total of 6 years)
- Re-election Rules: After reaching the limit, must sit out for one term before running again
- **Chair Election:** The Chair is elected annually

Appointment & Election Timeline

Spring 2025

- Full committee appointed by the Senate President (with the exception of Ex-Officio members)
- Appointments based on the membership criteria outlined in Slide 2
- Terms defined to initiate stagger I

One Year Term Duration

- 1 non-faculty staff member representing classified staff
- 1 Professional School statutory faculty member
- 2 CAS statutory faculty members

Two Year Term Duration

- 1 non-faculty staff member representing the officers of administration
- 2 Professional School statutory faculty members
- 2 CAS statutory faculty members

Appointment & Election Timeline

Spring 2026

- Elect replacements for the positions that started with a one-year term.
- ▶ These members will then serve a full two-year term (AY 2026-2028).

Spring 2027

- Elect replacements for the positions that initially had a full two-year term.
- These members will then serve a full two-year term (AY 2027-2029).
