The Distinguished Teaching Award Committee shall be responsible for ~~the screening, investigation and recommendation~~ reviewing, evaluating, and recommending of candidates to receive any Campus-wide teaching awards including, but not limited to, the Ersted Award for Distinguished Teaching and the Thomas F. Herman Faculty Achievement Award for Distinguished Teaching.

5) Membership Requirements:

Membership of the Distinguished Teaching Award Committee ~~is not fixed, but should consist of is fixed and consists of: at least 4-6 and not more than to 12-10 instructional~~ teaching faculty (Career and TTF) broadly representative of the faculty at-large, at least four-two of whom are past Distinguished Teaching Awards winners, and 2 are Career faculty, 1-student, and the-at least one representative from the Office of the Provost for Academic Affairs ~~Vice Provost for Academic Personnel~~ (ex officio, non-voting).

6) Leadership Structure (Chair, Convener &/or Staff):

- a) Chair: Elected from the membership
- b) Convener: ~~Senior~~ Vice Provost for Academic Affairs
- c) Staff: Office of the ~~Senior~~ Vice Provost for Academic Affairs
