Interim Provost Janet Woodruff-Borden

 Excited to welcome and begin working with new UO President (John) Karl Scholz, who is an amazing scholar and leader, and brings tremendous experience and new energy to the UO.



- Thank you to former Interim President Patrick Phillips and the opportunity to work closely with him over the last several years to remake the Office of the Provost into what it is now.
- Last week CAS finalized its Commencement program for 2023. There will be 5 programs/ceremonies where students will walk across a stage and be recognized individually. The plans for Commencement are now set for this year. A Commencement advisory workgroup has been formed and includes senators they will start to meet next week and continue working during spring term. One of their tasks will be to collect information on when folks want to hold ceremonies, timing, look for best practices, and ultimately develop a 5- year plan (2024 2028). There will be an opportunity for folks to provide feedback in April when this initiative begins.
- Faculty retention: the Office of the Provost is focusing its efforts on improving faculty experiences on campus and fostering a sense of belonging and engagement. We will be hold "Inclusive excellence and action" events, a 4-event series, (first event was held on March 3m 2023). This project is funded by an HHMI Grant for 6 years. Three more events will be held during Spring 2023. Keep an eye out for the scheduled for Wednesday, April 26, 2023 the Faculty Success: Inclusive Recruitment and Retention Summit, which will include a panel, a poster session, and breakout sessions. This project is partly an outgrowth of the recent work by Gerard Sandoval and Charlotte Moats-Gallagher to address campus climate concerns for faculty.
